Father/Son Canoe Trip Scheduled Feb 27 - Mar 1 in N. Florida

Our first annual canoe trip in 2008 was a big hit, and we're looking to repeat and build on the successes of last year. We've designed this paddling trip specifically for dads and their sons, creating an opportunity to enjoy time together experiencing many outdoor activities and personal growth.

We paddled the Santa Fe last year, so now we're going to check out the Suwannee. We will meet Friday evening, Feb 27 at the Suwannee River State Park, just 27 miles west of the I-10/I-75 interchange. On Saturday, we'll start with a hearty camp breakfast before dropping cars at the take out point and then driving to the put in. We plan to hit the water by 11 am, eat lunch down river around 1 pm, paddle and play for a few more hours and then enjoy an evening of food, fun and fellowship at an isolated, river-access campsite (complete with primitive cabins, restrooms and running water).



The Sunday morning paddle will only take a couple hours, allowing you to be back on the road by lunchtime. Space is limited, so reserve your spot today! Meals & Lodging

You will need to bring your own tents and sleeping bags for the trip. Bring dry bags or garbage bags to keep all of your gear dry (just to be safe!). All meals, from Saturday breakfast and including Sunday lunch, will be provided.

Fees & Payment

The father/son fee of \$250 includes meals, lodging and canoeing equipment. For fathers who wish to bring more than one son, the fee for each additional son will be \$75. Make checks payable to Camp Arrowhead, and please note that if your registration has to be cancelled, payment will be returned less a \$50.00 administrative fee, provided notice is given by February 13, 2009.
